As we return to full time in-person instruction we will: Use academic testing to identify learning gaps, implement in-school reading and math interventions, maximize research based curricular programs, provide educational technology to support learning, implement activities and services related to summer learning, and address the needs of at-risk children, children with disabilities, English learners, racial and ethnic minorities, students experiencing homelessness, students who must maintain a remote platform due to significant medical needs, and foster care youth.
